What the Studio is For

The Creative Studio is dedicated to creative projects only, including:

- Podcasting & music production
- Video editing & digital design
- 3D printing & laser cutting
- Robotics & electronics

(Note: this is not a study space or private workshop venue.)

Booking the Studio

- Bookings can be made online through the Campbelltown Library website.
 - Bookings that require a technician for specialist equipment must be booked 48 hours before the booking and be confirmed by the library service.
- Available to library members aged 16+.
- Customers under 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult, carer, or guardian who takes responsibility for the booking.
- Sessions can be up to 4 hours and held for 15 minutes after the start time. If the booking holder has not arrived within 15 minutes, the booking will be forfeited and the space may be reallocated.
- Only one booking in advance per member (up to one month in advanced).
- All sessions must finish 30 minutes before closing:
 - Mon–Thurs: 7:30 pm | Fri: 4:30 pm | Sat: 3:30 pm | Sun: 3:30pm
- The booking holder must be present, may bring up to 6 guests, and is responsible for the space.
- Customers may be held responsible for breakages or damage to equipment if caused by misuse.

Equipment Access & Costs

- Laser cutter & 3D printers: Available by appointment only.
- Costs: \$10 per laser-cut sheet | \$5 per 3D print.
- Bookings are otherwise free.

Conduct in the Space

- No nudity, alcohol, chewing gum, food, or drink (except water) is permitted in the space — even for creative or business-related purposes (e.g., photographing an alcohol advertisement).
- Respect shared equipment, furniture, and other users.
- Staff supervision is required for specialised equipment.
- The Creative Studio Space is a dynamic facility — equipment may be in different locations, and cables or items may be out of place after use. Customers are responsible for notifying staff of any potential hazards to prevent trips or injury.
- Unsafe, disruptive, or inappropriate behaviour may result in immediate cancellation or suspension of bookings.
